



Annual Vacancies – Boards, Commissions, Committees

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the Chartered City of Vista is seeking applicants to fill the 2010 scheduled vacancies. Government Code Section 54972 requires that a notice of scheduled vacancies on City Council-appointed boards, commissions, and committees be posted prior to December 31 each year.

The following is a list of the Board Members, Commissioners, and Committee Members whose terms will expire on June 30, 2010:

Crime and Substance Abuse Prevention Commission: Allan Lenefsky, Thomas Manning, and Margaret Reiber (three-year terms).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; and 2) 18 years of age.

Investment Advisory Committee: Robert Carter (three-year term).

Qualifications: 1) 18 years of age; and 2) qualified by virtue of education, training, experience, or background to serve in the capacity of advising the City on financial investment matters.

Mobilehome Park Review Board: Two unfilled vacancies (three-year term).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; 2) 18 years of age; and 3) shall not have any property, financial or economic interest as an owner, lessee, or tenant in any mobile home park.

Parks & Recreation Commission: John Henry Land and Linda Rhoades (three-year terms).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; and 2) 18 years of age.

Planning Commission: John Aguilera (four-year terms).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; 2) 18 years of age; and 3) shall not be employed by the City or be a member of the City Council.

Sales Tax Oversight Committee: Karl Ramsing, at-large representative; David Isa, financial/accounting representative; Jayne (Teene) Miller, Shadowridge HOA representative; and Bret Schanzenbach, Chamber of Commerce representative (two-year terms).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; and 2) 18 years of age.

Senior Citizens Affairs Commission: Nancy Kropf and Doug Regin (two-year terms).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; 2) 18 years of age; and 3) at least three members of the Commission must be 55 years of age or older.

Traffic Commission: Dianne Buran, Tina Cline (VUSD representative), and Terry Newman (three-year terms).

Qualifications: 1) Resident of the City of Vista; 2) 18 years of age.

All other applicants – March 25, 2010

Appointments will be made in June 2010, and the terms of office will begin July 1, 2010.
