We want to provide each camper with a positive experience to be able to meet new friends, share memories, be creative, laugh out loud, learn a new skill, play fun games, and be themselves. We can succeed in our efforts if we all work together and agree to the following guidelines.

		Camp Rules: I will follow the program rules as established. 1) Respect others and their property 2) keep hands, feet and objects to self 3) Respect materials and equipment 4) remain within the assigned boundaries 5) No backchat
		Behavior: I understand that this is a traveling camp program. As such, I will conduct myself in an appropriate manner and follow the directions given by the counselors, tour operators or bus driver. Failure to do so, may result in revocation of privileges.
		Trip Locations: I will exhibit appropriate respect for the tour operators, equipment and locations we visit. I understand that not doing so may jeopardize the camp's opportunity and mine to return.
		Active Participation: I understand my active participation is required for most activities. This may include hiking, swimming, running, playing or actively listening during a presentation or tour.
		Dress Code: I will wear the prescribed Day Camp shirt as assigned for specific days. I also understand that closed-toe athletic shoes are required at all times, even water days, and I will wear appropriate attire free from adult themed items.
		Money: I will not bring extra money as it is not allowed to be brought on field trips. The program will provide any extras as needed including game tokens, lunch/snacks or other items deemed necessary.
		Cell Phones: I will refrain from using a cell phone while at camp. As a recreation based program we strive to release campers from unneeded technology. If you have concerns, please contact the program coordinator.
		Group Assignment: I will respect the decision of the counselor in assigning me to a group. I will follow the instructions as given and not switch groups without asking.
		Language: I will use language that is appropriate at all times. I will not demean, denigrate or use explicit language (4-letter words) that are directed at any person, situation or object at anytime.
		Bullying/Teasing: I will refrain from harassing, antagonizing or taunting other campers, staff or associated individuals. Violations will be dealt with swiftly. A zero tolerance policy in regard to bullying or teasing is in effect.

I understand that I am fully responsible for my behavior and actions. I will also accept the consequences and learn from my mistakes. These may include but are not limited to discussion with camp staff or program supervisor, verbal/written warning, contact with parent, suspension for a specified period of time, expulsion from the program or any combination therein. All disciplinary actions will be at the discretion of the program supervisor depending on the severity of the infraction.
