Games and Practice

Game and practice schedules will be available on December 12, 2011. They may be picked up at Brengle Terrace Park after 5:00pm.

Officials

Parks and Community Services staff members will officiate games. When a child commits a foul or has a violation called against him, game officials will explain to the player why the whistle was blown.
