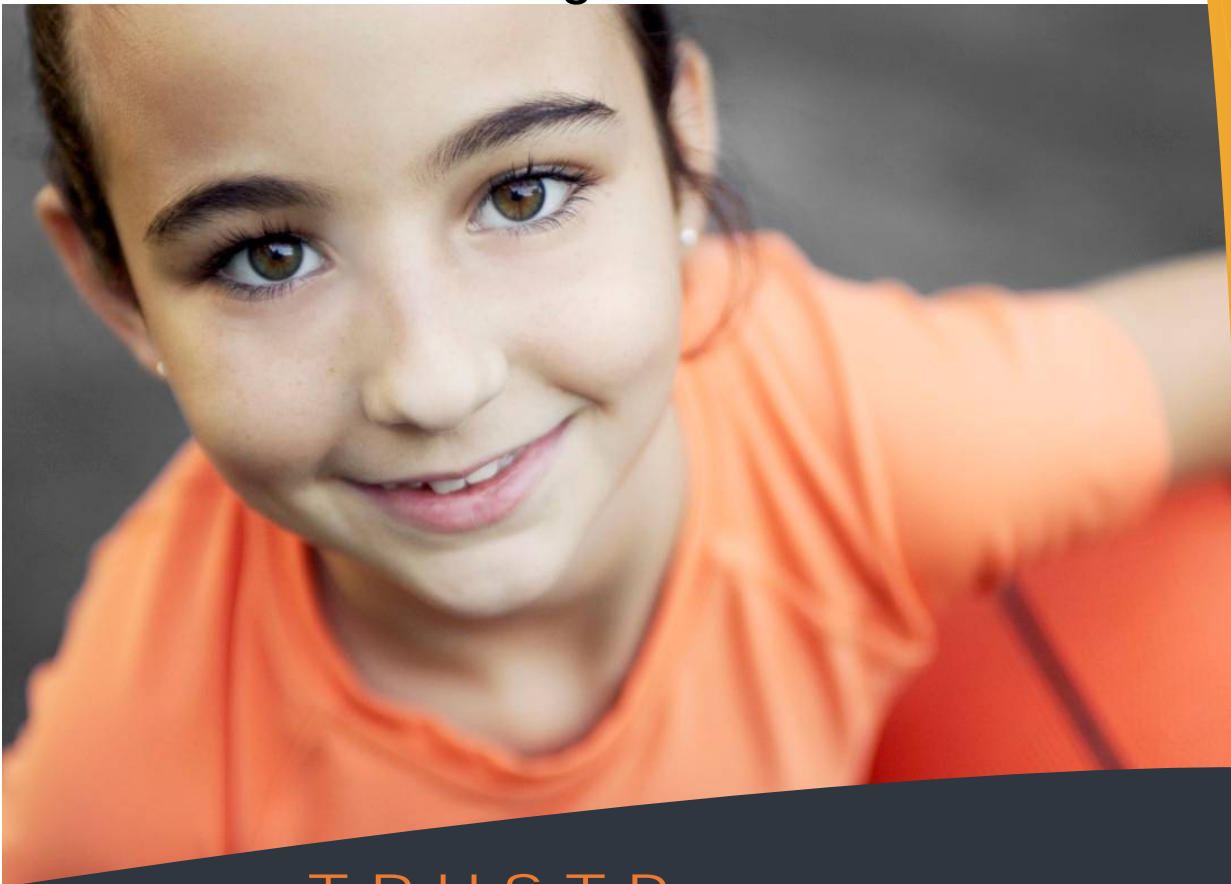

## PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Vista Youth Basketball Parent (YBA), you hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for each child participating in our League by following this Code of Conduct:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all children, managers and coaches (including those of an opposing team). This applies to every game, practice or any other YBA event
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all referees, league officials and parents at every game and event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of all children on all teams ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will ask my child to treat all other players, coaches, referees, league officials, and parents with respect.
- I promise to help my child enjoy YBA by being respectful to all players, coaches, referees, league officials, and parents.
- I will insist that all children play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will demand a drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free sports environment for all children and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all YBA games, practices and events.
- I will remember that YBA basketball is for children and not for adults.
- I will do all I can to make the game fun and safe for all the children involved in YBA.
- I understand that YBA is a volunteer organization that needs parent participation with timekeeping and scorekeeping and will help out when I can.
- I understand that team rules have been established to enable the Coaches to effectively conduct the affairs of the team in accordance with YBA rules. I understand my child is subject to team rules.



## COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

The City of Vista Recreation Division encourages a safe and healthy environment by supporting an environment free from:

- Drugs or alcohol
- Violence, intimidation or harassment
- Gambling or solicitation
- Profanity or abuse language
- Vandalism or property damage
- Officials abuse
- Object throwing
- Arguing with and/or harassing opposing team's coaches or parents for any reason
- Violating written division rules or safety rules
- Any display of unsportsmanlike conduct

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

I hereby acknowledge failure to abide by the Vista Youth Sports Code of Conduct may result in but not limited to the following outcomes:

- Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or head of league organization
- Written warning
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by organizations involved

- Parental season suspension
