

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC ART

The City of Vista's Public Art Commission is seeking public input on the mosaic to be installed on the facade of the Vista Branch Library, located at 700 Eucalyptus Avenue, Vista.

Name of Artist: Cherrie LaPorte

Type of Artwork: Mosaic Glass Sculpture

Title of Artwork: "Interconnection"



Proposed Mosaic Location



The “Interconnection” mosaic is a 42 inch circle mosaic glass sculpture.

The sculpture will cover a total of 9 square feet.

The approximate weight is 50 pounds.

Multiple colors of glass will be grouted and scaled.

The mosaic circle will be silicone into the recessed concrete area.

The anticipated life of the artwork is 50+ years.

The artist will provide annual cleaning of the mosaic; cost covered by Friends of the Vista Library.

Artist owns the rights to the design and will have first choice of sculpture if removed from the site.

This mosaic will be donated by the Friends of the Vista Library to the City of Vista.

Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed mosaic to be installed on the façade of the Vista Branch Library, located at 700 Eucalyptus Drive, Vista, during the public viewing period which will occur from September 16, 2017 to October 16, 2017.
