

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC ART

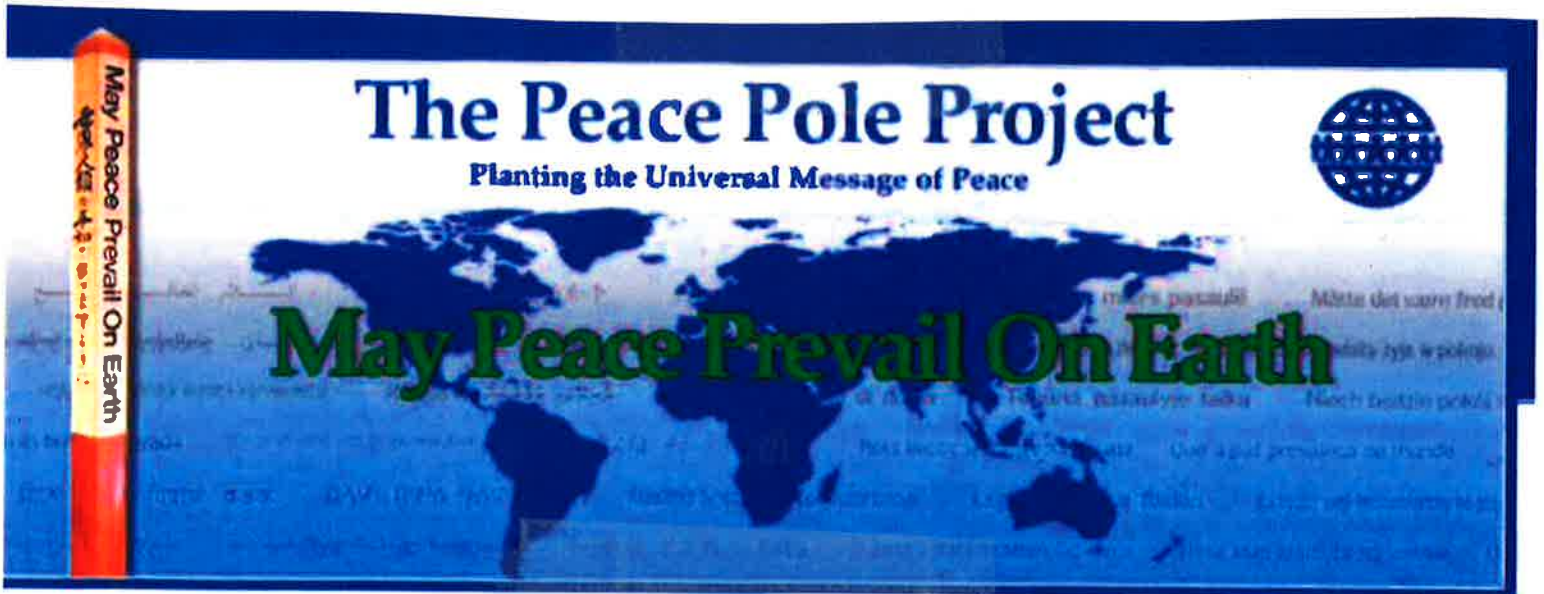
The City of Vista's Public Art Commission is seeking public input on the eight-foot vinyl pole to be placed on Main Street (across the street from Village Café).

Name of Artist: World Peace Pole Project – Lyn Berry

Type of Artwork: Eight-foot vinyl pole

Title of Artwork: "May Peace Prevail on Earth"

Eight-foot vinyl pole in white with black lettering. "May Peace Prevail on Earth" in eight languages of choice. Low maintenance and weatherproof.



A post hole would be dug. Cement would be poured and the pole would be "planted." The City of Vista Public Works staff would assist with the installation. The City would absorb the cost of cement.

Artwork poles are intended for durability. They wipe clean. They may "yellow" over extended time. Maintenance of area where pole is "planted" will be required.

Peace pole will be donated to the City.

Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed pole placement during the public viewing period which will occur from November 22, 2017 to January 2, 2018.
