## Rules & Regulations

- ◆ **Groups 25 and over are required to obtain a permit.**  
Permits can be obtained in the Recreation Office at the Vista Civic Center, 200 Civic Center Dr. or by calling the office at (760) 643-5268 or (760) 643-5275.
- ◆ **All parks close at dusk** unless a permit has been approved prior to the event by the Director of Recreation & Community Services Department.
- ◆ **Beer & Wine is not allowed in any City park** without an approved permit from the Recreation & Community Services Department. **No glass containers of any kind, no kegs and Beer & Wine permits will NOT be issued for youth oriented events (ie: birthday party)**
- ◆ **To have a Bounce House you MUST have a permit.**  
Quiet generators under 64db are required if electricity is not available. Bounce House providers must list the City of Vista additionally insured with an endorsement on their liability insurance with a current copy on file.
- ◆ **No overnight camping** allowed within City of Vista parks without written consent from the Director of Recreation & Community Services.
- ◆ **No defacing of public property** including cutting, breaking, damaging or changing the appearance of property (ie: graffiti / tagging). Violators will be prosecuted.
- ◆ **No amplified music** allowed in any City park without an approved permit from the Director of Recreation & Community Services.

## Rules & Regulations (cont.)

- ◆ **No littering**, please use trash receptacles throughout the park. Please use recycling bins where available. Groups with permits are responsible to clean-up after themselves.
- ◆ **Smoking is prohibited** within 50 feet of any playground, tot lot or City facility. This is measured from the border or if there is no border then the closest playground equipment.
- ◆ **Dogs must be on a leash** at all times, with the exception of South Buena Vista Park during the off-leash hours of 7-9am and 4pm-dusk. Bags are available throughout the parks for cleaning up after your pet.
- ◆ **No firearms, fireworks, firecrackers or fires** permitted on City Property. Barbecues must be used for cooking purposes only and coals disposed of properly.
- ◆ **No sales of merchandise &/or goods are permitted on City property** without written consent from the Director of Recreation & Community Services Department as well as proper licensing and permits.
- ◆ **Bicycling, Skateboarding, In-Line Skating & Scooters are prohibited** on any path, trail, walkway, recreation facility or anything designated as such.
