

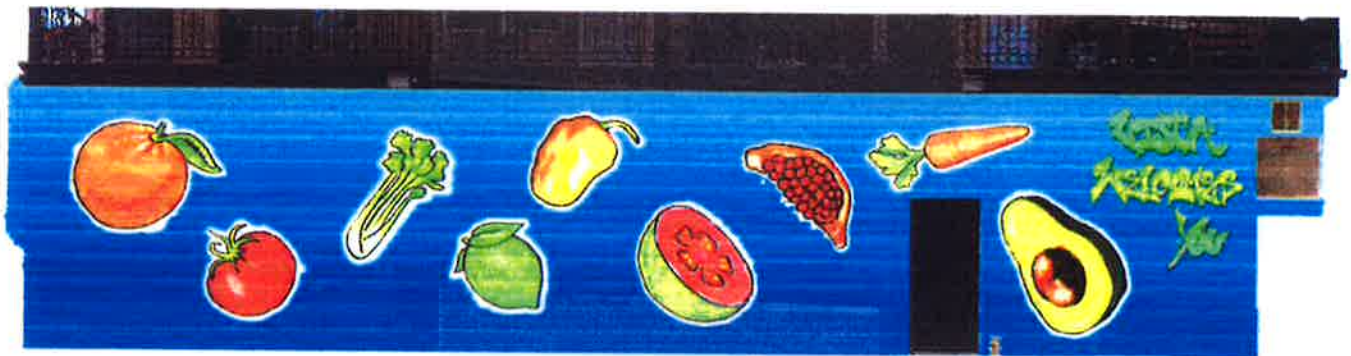
NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC ART

The City of Vista's Public Art Commission is seeking public input on the mural to be painted on the north-facing wall (West Connecticut Avenue) of the La Mexicana Market located at 440 North Santa Fe Avenue, Vista, CA

Name of Artist: Christina Curiel

Type of Artwork: Mural

Title of Artwork: "Fruits and Vegetables"



The proposed mural is entitled "Fruits and Vegetables." Mural painted directly on the north-facing wall of La Mexicana Market building. Dimensions of building wall: 15' (H) x 35' (L).

A layer of "Aquacote," water based lead free bulletin enamel specially designed for exposure to UV rays and outdoor elements, will be applied. Protective coating will be "Novacolor Polymer Medium." The life expectancy of the durable "Aquacote" is ten + years. "Aquacote" is "House of Color." The appearance of the mural will not change over time. Because of the high quality of the paint, a yearly pressure washing should keep it beautiful.

Funding will be provided by the Backfence Society, Inc.

Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed mural placement during the public viewing period which will occur from April 26, 2018 to May 29, 2018.
