

## FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

 **WEEK 1: FLAG YOUR CAMP:** Celebrating Flag Day **Potato Chip Rock! (June 10th)** Pack water and sunscreen. **San Diego History Center (June 11th)** The center tells the diverse history of our region. **Mormon Battalion Army of the West (June 12th)** The 330 Mormon Battalion arrived after marching almost 2,000 miles. Missionaries will guide the campers on an interactive tour lasting about an hour and a half. **Free Flight (June 14th)** What better way to end the first day of camp than a beach trip!


 **WEEK 2: BRING ON SUMMER: Torrey Pines Hike & Beach (June 17th)** 1,750 acre reserve dedicated to preserving its namesake, the Torrey Pine Tree, and other indigenous wildlife in its native environment. **City Fun Center! (June 18th)** A retro amusement center for all ages, with bumper boats! Play where ticket and redemption games are operated by nickels. **The Wave Waterpark (June 20th)** The Crazy River, The Flowrider, Tublation & Slam Dunk are just some of the attractions the kids will get to experience. A swim test will be administered to everyone. If they don't pass, they will be required to wear a life vest and will not go on the slides. **Irvine Spectrum Irvine Spectrum Center** is one of Southern California's most popular entertainment destinations. Camper will have the opportunity

 **WEEK 3: Archway of the Skyway: John Wayne Airport (June 24th)** Tour will include an explanation of how planes fly, the Wright Brothers' flight, baggage carousels, and flight display monitors. **Air and Space Museum (June 25th)** A day of aviation and space exploration. The museum is divided into many galleries with exhibits emphasizing the contribution San Diego has made to aviation. **Bob Maxwell Memorial Airfield (June 27th)** This airfield covers just 43 acres and is used for general aviation. Skydivers will be

there. **WEEK 4: HOLIDAYS AROUND THE WORLD: Boomers (July 2nd)** Bumper boats, miniature golf and unlimited video games are in store for this fun-filled day at one of our most popular local attractions! Plus celebrating Easter, Valentines Day, even Christmas in July!

 **WEEK 5: FITNESS FANATICS: Eagle Rock (July 8th)** Eagle Rock is perhaps the most aptly named rock formation. This awesome pile of granite bears an astonishing resemblance of an enormous raptor with outstretched wings. **Quince & Spruce Street Bridges (July 12th)** This will be great fun at two of San Diego's amazing bridges. Quince Street is a 236 foot-long bridge crossing 60 feet of Maple Canyon. Spruce Street is the iconic, gently swaying suspension bridge built in 1912 that crosses Kate Sessions Canyon.

**WEEK 6: ICE CREAM DREAMS: Dave's Rock Garden (July 16th)** Featured on CBS's The Zevely Zone, this garden was started by neighbor Dave and is primarily rocks. Campers will paint a rock to add to the garden. **Bates Nut Farm (July 17th)** The campers will learn the history of the Bates family and farm. The tour includes identification of various nuts, a hayride, feeding the animals and a personal snack bag. **The Wave Waterpark (July 18th)** The Crazy River, The Flowrider, Tublation & Slam Dunk are just some of the attractions the kids will get to experience. A swim test will be administered to everyone. If they don't pass they will be required to wear a life vest and will not go on the slides


 **WEEK 7: THE WILD WEST: Altitude Trampoline Park (July 22nd)** **<Waiver Required>** This place is jumping! 18,000 feet of indoor trampolines, a foam pit, rock climbing and much more entertainment. **The Wave Waterpark (July 26th)** The Crazy River, The Flowrider, Tublation & Slam Dunk are just some of the attractions the kids will get to experience. A swim test will be administered to everyone. If they don't pass they will be required to wear a life vest and will not go on the slides.

**WEEK 8: SUMMER BEACH WEEK: Oceanside Harbor (July 29TH)** Be sure to send your camper with their bathing suit, towel and sunscreen because they will get WET! This sandy peninsula has stunning ocean views. **Boomers (July 30th)** Bumper boats, miniature golf and unlimited video games are in store for this fun-filled day at one of our most popular local attractions! **Buccaneer Beach (July 30th)** This is Oceanside's smallest beach with a lifeguard tower. The beach offers other activities, thanks to the park located across the street.

**WEEK 9: WATER WONDERS Tamarack Beach (Aug. 5th)** This beach is ideal for the campers. It offers swimming, body surfing and beachcombing. **The Rube H. Fleet Science Center (Aug. 6th)** This is one of the favorite places to go, and with hands-on experiments throughout the museum, the kids have a blast. After the museum, campers will have lunch at the Balboa Park playground. **Wave Waterpark (Aug. 10th)** The Crazy River, The Flowrider, Tublation & Slam Dunk are just some of the attractions the kids will get to experience. A swim test will be administered to everyone. If they don't pass they will be required to wear a life vest and will not go on the slides.

## SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAM

 The California Department of Education Summer Food Program provides free meals to children, 18 and under, at Jim Porter Recreation Center (formerly Brengle Terrace), located at 1200 Vale Terrace Drive in the City of Vista. Since school meals are not available during summer vacation, children can rely on the Summer Food Program to provide nutritious food that will assist them to grow to their full potential. Youth simply show up at the site during the time meals are being served, and enjoy good company and a delicious meal. Meals must be eaten onsite.



The free lunches are served from Noon to 12:45 p.m., Monday-Friday, from June 10 through August 9, 2019 at the Recreation Center.
