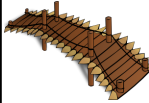
FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

WEEK 1: FLAGS OF THE WORLD: SAN DIEGO HISTORY CENTER (June 11th) The History Center presents engaging family-friendly exhibitions. Participatory activities tell the remarkable stories of our region's past, present and future.

WEEK 2: IT'S A SUMMER PARTY: THE WAVE WATERPARK (June 20th) Get ready for some fun in the sun! For those who don't know how to swim, they will hang out in the Splash Pad which is a no-depth water zone. In order to go in the pool or the lazy river, campers will pass an administered swim test.

WEEK 3: THE SKY'S THE LIMIT: FREE FLIGHT (June 27th) Free Flight is the place where parrots and people interact in a tropical outdoor setting. Located in Del Mar, this is a unique exotic bird sanctuary where campers will learn about species of rare and endangered birds.

WEEK 4: CELEBRATING HOLIDAYS BOOMERS! (July 2nd) What a great way to spend a summer day. Bumper Boats, Miniature Golf and unlimited video games are in store for this fun-filled day at one of our most popular local attractions!



WEEK 5: RUN, WALK, JOG, STAY FIT: SPRUCE AND QUINCE STREET SUSPENSION BRIDGE (July 12th) This will be great fun at two of San Diego's amazing bridges. Quince Street is a 236 foot-long bridge crossing 60 feet of Maple Canyon. Spruce Street is the iconic gently swaying suspension bridge built in 1912 that crosses Kate Sessions Canyon.



WEEK 6: ICE CREAM IS THE SCOOP: THE WAVE WATERPARK (July 18th) Get ready for some fun in the sun! For those who don't know how to swim, they will hang out in the Splash Pad which is a no-depth water zone. In order to go in the pool or the lazy river, campers will pass an administered swim test.



WEEK 7: COUNTRY WESTERN ALTITUDE VISTA (July 22th) <Waiver Required> This place is jumping! 18,000 feet of indoor trampolines, a foam pit, rock climbing and much more entertainment.

WEEK 9: SPLISH SPLASH REUBEN H. FLEET SCIENCE CENTER (Aug. 6th) This is one of the favorites, and with hands-on experiments throughout the museum, the kids have a blast. After the museum, campers will have lunch at the Balboa Park playground.

Youth simply show up at the site during the time meals are being served, and enjoy good company and a delicious meal. Meals must be eaten onsite.




The free lunches are served from Noon to 12:45 p.m., Monday-Friday, from June 10 through August 9, 2019 at the Recreation Center.
