ORDINANCE NO. 2018-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CHARTERED CITY OF VISTA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 12.14.010 OF THE VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING UNLEASHED DOGS WITHIN SOUTH BUENA VISTA PARK

The City Council of the City of Vista does ordain as follows:

- 1. Findings. The City Council hereby finds and declares all of the following:
- The City Council desires to amend Section 12.14.010, of the Vista Municipal A. Code concerning hours during which unleashed dogs are permitted within certain parks.

2. **Code Amendment**

- Paragraph A of Section 12.14.010 of the Vista Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:
 - The unleashed dog is: (1) within the natural areas served by trails "A. within South Buena Vista Park; and (2) is present in those areas only during park operating hours. For the purpose of this section, the phrase "natural areas" shall mean those areas within South Buena Vista Park that are kept in a native condition, and does not include the parking lot, tot lot or basketball court."
- 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on the thirty-first day following the date of its adoption.
