The City of Vista's Public Art Commission is seeking public input on the artwork to be painted on the existing poles in the Australasian Garden section of the Alta Vista Botanical Gardens.

Title of Artwork: 1. Lizards 2. Snake

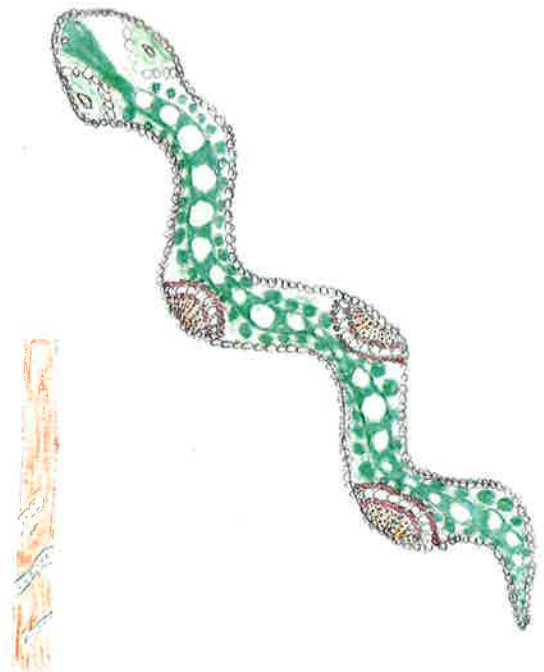

The proposed mural is entitled "1 Lizards 2 Snake." Mural painted directly on the existing poles located in the Australasian Garden section of the Alta Vista Botanical Gardens.

The poles will have the paint applied directly to their surfaces using standard house paint in the style of aboriginal dot painting. The poles are currently not serving any other purpose. They are located at two of the areas to the garden.

Depending on the elements, the anticipated life of the artwork is 5-10 years.

Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed mural placement during the public viewing period which will occur from August 22, 2018 to September 24, 2018.
