

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CHARTERED CITY OF VISTA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 3.52 OF THE VISTA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING CENTRAL VISTA BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD APPOINTMENTS

The City Council of the City of Vista does ordain as follows:

1. Findings. The City Council hereby finds and declares the following:

A. On November 27, 2018, directed staff to terminate the agreement with the VVBA for administration for the Central Vista Business Improvement District, to work with the VVBA to close out open projects, and for City staff to administer the BID for the remainder of the fiscal year.

B. Because the VVBA is no longer administering the CVBID, the following code amendment is needed to revise the appointment process.

2. Code Amendment.

A. Section 3.52.040 B of the Vista Municipal Code is amended to read:

"B. The City Council shall appoint seven persons to the Advisory Board. The appointees shall be owners of businesses subject to the assessments within the District unless otherwise qualified and acceptable candidates meeting this requirement are unavailable."

B. Section 3.52.040 C of the Vista Municipal Code is deleted in its entirety.

3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become part of the Vista Municipal Code on the 31st day following the date of adoption.

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4. Adoption. INTRODUCED and ADOPTED at a meeting of the City Council held on January 22, 2019, by the following vote:
