NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Vista for furnishing all labor, materials, and all other items and facilities necessary therefore, as provided in **the Invitation for Bid and Project Specifications for the 2018 PEDESTRIAN MOBILITY SIDEWALK PROJECT (C.I.P. No. 8290, CFDA No. 14-218, Grant Number: B-18-MC-06-0575)** in strict accordance with the Project Specifications and Plans on file at the Office of the City Engineer.

Bids will be received at the Office of the City Clerk, Vista Civic Center, 200 Civic Center Drive, 2nd Floor, Vista, California 92084, until **2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 20, 2019**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the title of the project plainly marked on the outside.

The project is located on **Bobolink Drive from East Drive to Ricebird Drive** in the City of Vista, CA. The work to be included in the bid generally consists of: **storm water pollution prevention and erosion control, survey monument preservation, traffic control and construction staging, clearing and grubbing, site grading and subgrade preparation, aggregate base, PCC curb & gutter, PCC cross gutter and spandrel, PCC curb ramp, PCC driveway, PCC sidewalk, asphalt concrete paving for street structural section repair, signing and striping, crushed rock water quality infiltration swale, and other related work.**

The Engineer's Construction **Cost Estimate** for this project is **\$351,000.00**. Bid documents will be available for inspection without charge at the Office of the City Engineer, 200 Civic Center Drive, Vista, CA 92084. The project is also listed on the City of Vista web page <http://www.cityofvista.com/city-government/public-meetings-bids-contracts> . Bid Documents may be purchased for \$35.00 per set at the Vista Engineering Department. There is a \$15 charge for mailing.

FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS :

1. This project is being financed with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds (24 CFR Part 570) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). All contracts using this federal funding are subject to certain Special Federal Provisions and additional Federal Requirements.

2. The Contractor will be required to comply with Federal Davis-Bacon Act requirements. The Contractor will be required to comply with all of the terms and conditions (including Federal and State General Prevailing Wage requirements) prescribed for Contractor performing public works construction projects. In all

instances where Federal, State, and Local Prevailing Wages for a given craft differ, the higher Prevailing Wage shall be paid.

3. The Contractor to whom the Contract is awarded, and any subcontractor under such Contractor, shall hereby ensure that minority and women business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids for subcontracts. Further, there shall be no discrimination in employment practices on the basis of race, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical handicap, medical condition, marital status, age, or sex.

4. Information pertaining to federal CDBG Construction Contract requirements are included in Appendices A, B, and C of the Invitation for Bids and Project Specifications for this Project. Bidders are required to review and comply with all federal requirements.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on **WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2019**, at **10:00 AM** in the Delpy Conference Room located on the first floor of the City of Vista Civic Center, 200 Civic Center Drive, Vista, CA 92084. The scope of the Project, the bidding requirements, and CDBG Program reporting procedures will be discussed and comments and questions from prospective bidders will be addressed. **PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND.**
