NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Vista for furnishing all labor, materials, and all other items and facilities necessary therefor, as provided in the Contract Documents, for the

**“BUB WILLIAMSON PARK RENOVATION PROJECT”
(C.I.P. NO. 8282)”**

in strict accordance with the Project Specifications and Plans on file at the Office of the City Engineer.

Due to COVID-19 health restrictions, **the Civic Center is not open to the public and the bids will be opened via live stream video** in the Council Chambers at the City of Vista Civic Center, 200 Civic Center Drive, Vista, CA 92084-6275, on THURSDAY, APRIL 23, 2020, at 4pm, at which time the bids will be opened via live stream on the City’s website by going to the following link: <https://www.cityofvista.com/city-hall/agenda-minutes/meeting-video-broadcast>.

Bid submitted by mail, shall be typewritten or written clearly and legibly in ink and submitted in sealed envelopes plainly marked BUB WILLIAMSON PARK RENOVATION PROJECT (C.I.P. No. 8282) DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL” on the outside.

PLEASE NOTE: Mail deliveries to the Civic Center will be limited to mail delivered by the United States Postal Service, which will only be processed twice per week by City staff. Deliveries from other companies including UPS and FedEx will no longer be accepted at the Vista Civic Center. **The Civic Center will be open from 2pm to 4pm, on the advertised bid date to allow hand delivered Bids.** Because of COVID-19 health restrictions, the City encourages all Bidders to mail their Bids for this project at least one week before the Bid Opening Date, or they may not be processed in time to for the Bid Opening. Bids may be hand-delivered on the bid date by the Bidder, but this is being discouraged. Bidders are not able to be present at the Bid Opening, the Bid Opening will be done by the City Clerk via live stream. Bidders can view the opening by going to the City website.

The project site is located: **530 Grapevine Lane**, in the City of Vista, CA.

A MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING and site visit will be held on WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4 AT 2:00 PM at 200 Civic Center Drive, Vista, CA. The site visit will be held immediately following the pre-bid meeting at 530 Grapevine Lane, Vista, CA. **Due to COVID-19**, a teleconference and self-guided site visit will be held on MONDAY, MARCH 16 AT 2:00 PM and THURSDAY, APRIL 9 AT 2:00 PM. The conference number is 760.643.5401, meeting number 5208#, access code 5051#. **Interested proposers are only required to attend or participate in one meeting.** PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND.

The work to be included in the bid generally consists of:

Stormwater pollution prevention and erosion control, survey monument preservation, traffic control and construction staging, clearing and grubbing, site grading and subgrade preparation, aggregate base, PCC curb & gutter, PCC cross gutter and spandrel, PCC curb ramp, PCC driveway, PCC sidewalk, asphalt concrete paving for street structural section repair, parking lot reconstruction, signing and striping, installation of playgrounds/play equipment/protective surfacing, water fountains, bike racks, gazebos, fitness stations, remodeling of existing restroom building, landscape and irrigation installation, installation of low voltage power and underground electrical runs, control devices, panel boards and lighting poles, bioretention basins, backflow preventer, water reconnect, retaining walls, fencing, grind and pave, signing and striping, and temporary erosion control and BMPs and other related work as shown in plans.

This project is being financed with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds (24 CFR Part 570) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). All contracts using this federal funding are subject to certain Special Federal Provisions and additional Federal Requirements. The Contractor will be required to comply with Federal Davis-Bacon Act requirements. The Contractor will be required to comply with all of the terms and conditions (including Federal and State General Prevailing Wage requirements) prescribed for Contractor performing public works construction projects. In all instances where Federal, State, and Local Prevailing Wages for a given craft differ, the higher Prevailing Wage shall be paid. The Contractor to whom the Contract is awarded, and any subcontractor under such Contractor, shall hereby ensure that minority and women business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids for subcontracts. Further, there shall be no discrimination in employment practices on the basis of race, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical handicap, medical condition, marital status, age, or sex.

Information pertaining to federal CDBG Construction Contract requirements are included in Appendices A, B, and C of the Invitation for Bids and Project Specifications for this Project. Bidders are required to review and comply with all federal requirements.

The Contractor shall possess a valid California Class A General Engineering Contractor License at the time that the Contract is awarded.

The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost for this Project is: **two million seven hundred thirty-five thousand six hundred dollars, (\$2,735,600.00) for the Base Bid; and four hundred and forty thousand dollars for (\$440,000.00) Bid Alternate A.**
